Timeline on repair to enable access.</b></p> <p><b>Action:</b> DTS to reassess the accessibility of Yarrow Road with a view to undertake repairs.</p>	<b>TS</b>	<p>29.02.24 – Yarrow Road was reopened on 27.02.24 – The community should note Council Resolution 111/2223 which resolved that Council:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Takes no further action to improve access across the Merrygoen Creek causeway on Yarrow Road, Mendooran.</li> <li>2. Informs the residents of Mendooran that Council is unable to provide a safe and dry access across the causeway that is affordable by the Shire at this time.</li> <li>3. Further assesses and considers options as the weather conditions change and the conditions of the creek improve.</li> <li>4. Supports the Department of Planning and Environment seeking an expression of interest for the licensing of sand extraction from the site.</li> </ol> <p>It should be further noted, that works to remove sand are a short-term solution as the sand will build up again over time.</p>	In Progress

Council continue to assess the causeway and remove built up sand as required to assure accessibility.</li> </ol> <p>12.09.24 – Sand was removed up to 8 metres, however the water still remains covering the causeway which is too high to open to traffic.</p>	In Progress
