OK!

- Paper/cardboard
- Aluminium and steel tins/cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Glass bottles/jars
- Plastic soft-drink and water bottles
- Plastic tubs and trays
- Juice/milk cartons and bottles

Warrumbungle Shire Council provides you with a general waste bin (black lid) and a recycling bin (yellow lid). General waste is collected weekly and recycling is collected fortnightly. Put your bins out the night before collection day, near the kerb and in a spot where they won't block pedestrian, bicycle or vehicle access.

Did you know the number in the triangle identifies the type of plastic a container is made from, not whether or not it is recyclable? And, you do not have to rinse containers before putting them in the recycling bin. Containers just need to be empty and dry.

NOT OK!

- Plastic bags
- Polystyrene (foam packaging)
- Light globes,
- Mirrors and window glass
- Crockery, drinking glasses and Pyrex
- Sharps/syringes
- Nappies
